

Genes and Development Summer Studentships 2015

Purpose: to support vacation research by undergraduate geneticists

Grants are available to provide financial support for undergraduate students interested in gaining research experience in any area of genetics by carrying out a research project over the long vacation, usually prior to their final year.

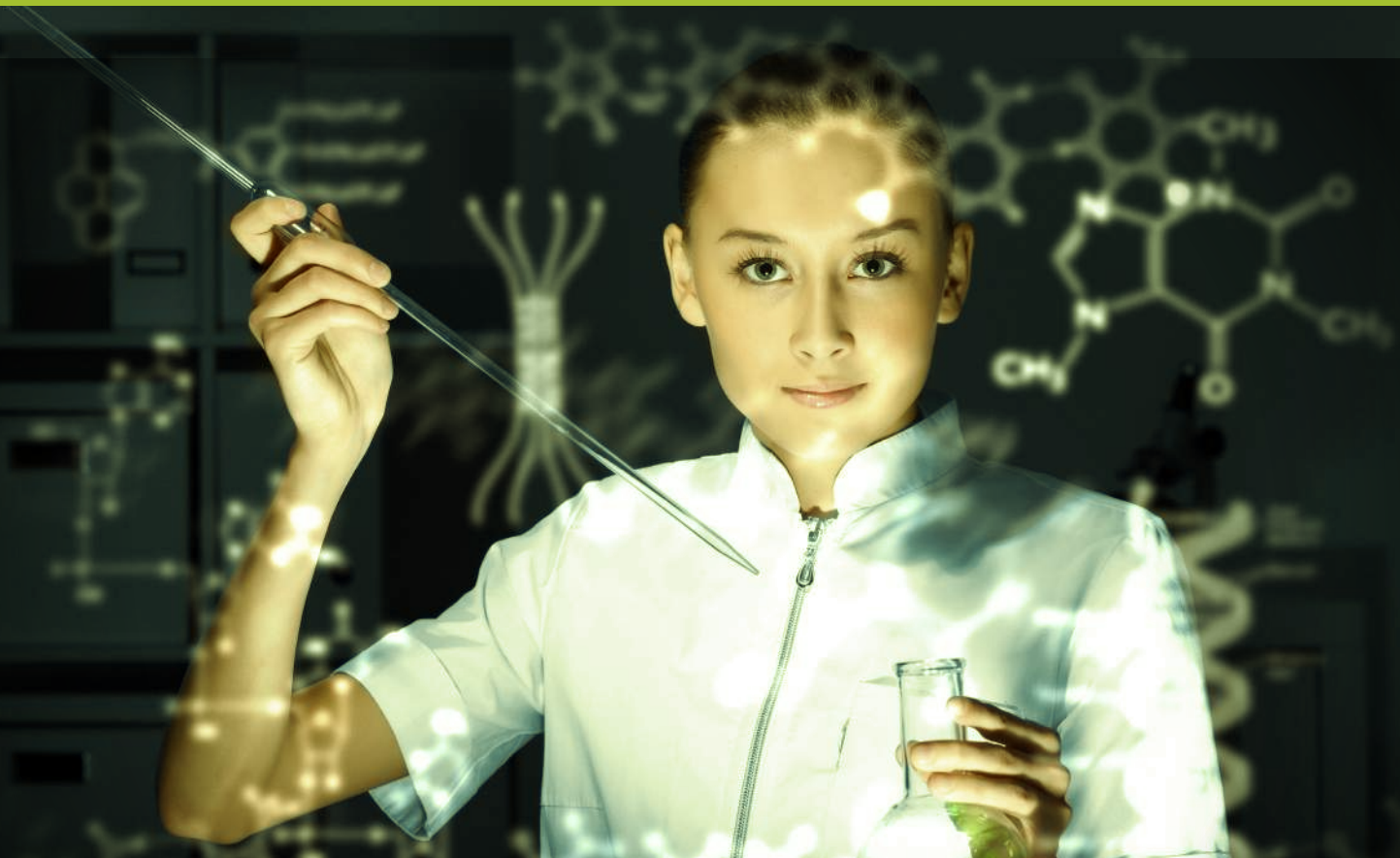
Applications must be made by Principal Investigators (PI) at Universities or Research Institutes. The application must be for a named student and is not transferable.

The studentship will consist of an award of £200 per week for up to 8 weeks to the student

plus a grant of up to £750 to cover expenses incurred by the host laboratory: lab expenses must be justified. The project should be realistic and achievable by a student in this timeframe: attention should be paid to student training needs in the application. The award will be made to the host institution.

Students will also be invited to attend a workshop which will take place at the start of September to allow an opportunity for all students to get together, discuss their findings and start to develop their professional contact network.

Closing date for application is 31st March 2015
